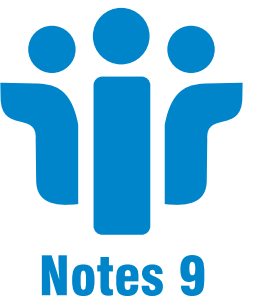


IBM Notes 9 Social Edition at a Glance

The first release of Lotus Notes was shipped 24 years back in 1989. More than 35,000 copies were sold

IBM purchased Lotus Software in 1995 for \$3.5 billion, primarily to acquire Lotus Notes

IBM has dropped the "Lotus" brand name and the product will be called IBM Notes henceforth

Open Social



The OpenSocial component provides social and web features to make third-party processes available directly in the client user's mail. The OpenSocial component supports:

Security



SAML Authentication

Security Assertion Markup Language (SAML) allows a user to authenticate once with a designated identity provider (IdP), after which the user can access any server that is partnered with the IdP. Both Notes client and Web client users can make use of SAML based authentication.



SHA-2

SHA-2 is currently available to use for X.509 certificate signature verification and S/MIME signed mail, and some areas of Notes/Domino where a password such as the Internet (HTTP) password was previously "hashed."



OAuth

OAuth is an open standard authorization that allows user credentials to be shared with compliant applications so that users avoid extra password prompts.

High availability with low efforts



A new unified Database Management Tool has been introduced that can help administer servers better. The tool will enable admins to do their daily and weekly tasks.

The dbmt tool can

- ❖ Run copy-style compact operations
- ❖ Purge deletion stubs
- ❖ Expire soft deleted entries
- ❖ Update views
- ❖ Reorganize folders
- ❖ Merge full text indexes
- ❖ Update unread lists

An enterprise class web application server



Quality of Service (QoS)

QoS is a feature that can increase the reliability and keep the server up at all times. QoS probing can be configured to email an administrator about the problem and/or automatically terminate the server and restart it



IBM HTTP Server in front of domino server. Purpose of this enhancement is to support the Transport Layer Security (TLS) protocol. This server module is supported only on Windows

Get control over enterprise client management



IBM Notes 9 gives additional controls to administrators to do additional policy changes

AUTO_SORT_DATE=11 or 12

Enables the preference: Automatically sort date columns (12 enables most recent on bottom)

TypeaheadShowServerFirst =1

When users affected by the policy see a typeahead list, the server lists server results first, and then a Search Local Directory for name option.
